
# Adam Mars shares with lifo.gr 20 slogans about the digital era

# Your phrase «Banksy Sucks» is one of the most recognizable. What do you think about Banksy today? Do you have any favorite street artists?



#### What is your opinion about Barack Obama?


I think he has a hard job. I wouldn't want to work in the oval office.
